Logline

When astronauts make first contact on Mars, the world believes it's happening live. But NASA is secretly an hour ahead, using a 60-minute broadcast delay to control what the public sees. As leaders debate whether to respond, one outsider uncovers the truth - too late.

Short synopsis

The first manned Mars landing is broadcast live across the globe. But in reality, NASA has enforced a secret 60-minute delay on all transmissions, giving them time to handle unforeseen crises—or suppress them. So when the astronauts receive a peaceful message from an intelligent alien presence, NASA doesn't share it. Not yet. As internal debate rages over whether to engage, one low-level systems analyst discovers the deception. But by the time the truth reaches the surface, the world's chance to answer is already gone.

Real-time science fiction thriller. Tense, cerebral, urgent. In the spirit of Arrival, Eye in the Sky, and Fail Safe.

Theme

Truth vs. control, Fear of the unknown, The ethics of power and silence.

Visual style

Real-time storytelling over 120 minutes

Stark contrast between the sterile, high-tech NASA control room and the vast, silent Martian surface Heavy use of timecode overlays, security feeds, atmospheric audio layering Understated, realistic effects to amplify tension rather than spectacle

Nia Calder: Quiet, sharp systems analyst who first uncovers the delay and hidden signal

Director Harlan Graves: Veteran NASA official, balancing truth and global risk

President Monroe: The cautious political leader who must authorize the final decision

Commander Vega: Mars mission leader who hears the message firsthand

Dr. Amir Elbaz: Astrobiologist, emotionally invested in responding
